The rental agreement begins with a four month trial period through our school instrumental music supplier. At the end of 4 months, you would decide if you wish to continue the rental. Damage waiver plans are also available. Instruments are available for rent to own. You have the option of renting the instruments independently if you do not wish to use our instrumental supplier. If you own an instrument, you will not need to participate in the rental program.

RENT-TO-OWN FAQs

What is an Instrument Trial?

Coles will start every new student with either a 4 month or School-Year Trial period to allow your child to try out an instrument without a financial commitment to buy. The single fixed price covers the instrument rental for the full trial period.

Why do I need a Damage Waiver? Accidents happen and Coles understands. Your child is being introduced to an instrument that requires assembly and care. We offer the Damage Waiver to cover mishaps that may occur.

How does my child get their instrument? A Coles representative visit your child's school once a week, and their instrument will be delivered to their instructor.

What happens after the Trial Period ends? When the Trial Period is completed, you will begin the Rent-To-Own program, during which your monthly payments will be applied toward the purchase of the instrument. The length of the rental term until ownership varies by instrument, and the rental agreement may be terminated at any time.
