Dear Parent/Guardian,

A child in our school has or is suspected of having Hand, Foot, and Mouth Disease. The disease is spread by close contact. The symptoms of Hand, Foot, and Mouth Disease are fever and blisters on the hands, feet, and mouth. The disease can be prevented simply by washing with soap and water. Classrooms are currently being disinfected by maintenance staff. When your child is home, please monitor for the following: fever and rash. If your child contracts Hand, Foot, and Mouth Disease, they need to be seen by their doctor. All areas need to be cleared, the child must be fever free for 24 hours and a note must be sent to the school from their doctor. If your child has any symptoms of this disease, call your doctor or other healthcare provider to find out what to do. Be sure to tell him or her about this notice. If you do not have a regular provider to care for your child, contact your local health department for instructions on how to find a doctor, or ask another parent for names of their children's provider.
